



## **PA Housing Search**

A list of affordable accessible apartments can be found on the PA Housing Search website at <a href="https://www.pahousingsearch.com">www.pahousingsearch.com</a>. The PA Housing Search website allows you to search by county or city for rental housing. The listings on the website include information such as:

- address,
- management contact information,
- unit size,
- > rent.
- > availability, and
- > whether or not smoking is permitted.
- accessibility features, such as:
  - ✓ whether the building entrance and unit entrance are wide enough for a wheelchair,
  - ✓ bathroom grab bars,
  - ✓ roll-in shower,
  - ✓ counter height, and
  - ✓ types of appliance controls.

There are also photos of many of the listings; a location map; and information about nearby amenities like parks, schools, and hospitals. Finally, the website has other helpful resources such as calculators for affordability and moving costs, rental checklists and alerts for real estate scams and foreclosures.

**Finally Home** is a demonstration project of Values into Action funded by the Pennsylvania Developmental Disabilities Council (PADDC) to assist individuals with disabilities from rural communities in meeting their goals to access and maintain control of their own homes. Diana T. Myers and Associates, Inc.
